



The Nassau County Police Department and Nassau BOCES are partnering to provide Nassau County schools with information on how to prepare for a critical incident including an Active Shooter.

A series of informational sessions will be held at the Nassau County Police Department's Morrelly Center. This training will be geared toward Principals and Assistant Principals as these administrators are responsible for preparing their staff and students for emergencies. In furtherance of this mission, representatives from Nassau BOCES and NCPD Homeland Security will present timely information to assist in training. Topics will include developing Emergency Response Plans, current training guidelines and strategies to assist law enforcement in maintaining situational awareness. The Nassau County Police Department will also provide an overview of their response to an Active Shooter.

Each session will contain the same instructional content but the specific training dates will be structured to allow school administrators an opportunity to interact with their local Precinct Administration and POP officers.
